Admission

Admission decisions will be based on the candidate's portfolio. Requirements are as follows: UAS Bachelor's degree in viticulture and enology (or related field)

Bachelor's degree in a related field from a University or Institute of Technology, subject to completing a practical internship.

Other applications are judged on the academic curriculum and practical experience.

Candidates must hold a B2 level in English according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Registration from December until April 30.


